NOTE: a basic supply list to be purchased before the first class. Artist Quality paints or professional grade, better brushes and surfaces will make the work easier and more enjoyable.

Acrylic or Oil [water soluble, alkyd/resin or standard] Paint Colours

Primary Yellow

Yellow Ocher or Raw Sienna or Yellow Oxide

Magenta [primary red]

Cyan [primary blue]

Raw Umber – neutral colour

Black – Carbon or Mars for opaque and if wanted Bone Black for transparency

White – Titanium for opaque and/or Zinc for transparency

Add any other colours you wish including Interference or metallic paints

NOTE: many acrylic paints come in transparent or opaque versions – at this time choose opaque.

Mediums for Acrylic or Oil

Acrylic

Polymer – ie: Golden's GAC 100

Gels – Heavy Body in both Gloss & Matt - ie: Liquitex

Oil

Gels/Paste – can be used instead of other mediums and can offer texture and sheen

Brushes

3 sizes of each type of brush – small, medium and large

Types: Filbert, Round, Bright &/or Flat

Long handle Brushes are best for standing easel work which I encourage

Short handle Brushes are best for working seated for those who cannot stand

Nylon is best for precise and controlled work. Bristle allows softness and easier blending.

Firm brushes are required – not soft watercolour brush quality

Palette Knife [Painting Knives are the more correct term]

Medium to Large sized Metal Knives with a bent handle

Pie shape and a Long Flat Knife are required. Add any others you want.

Palette

Large Disposable with or without thumb hole

Wet Palette – large or small – optional

Painting Surfaces any size – Canvas: Boards, Stretched, or Pads – whichever you prefer ie: 16x20

Drawing Pad any size - for Notes, Ideas and Thumbnails

Other:

Fabric Towels – not paper

Large (2ft sq approx) towel or heavy T-shirt material

Smaller towel/sock

Spray Bottle that makes a fine mist – for acrylics only

Tape

2 – 3 foot String

Coloured Tissue Paper, Printed Images and Text from Mag or Newspaper - bring a variety for 1st Classes
