## **MATERIALS LIST**

### **Acrylic Paint**

Finest Quality/Professional Heavy Body or Fluid Acrylics preferred.

### **Suggested colours:**

- Pyrrole Red Medium or Naphthol Red Light (60ml)
- Phthalo Blue (Green Shade) (60ml)
- Any medium yellow ie. Primary Yellow, Hansa Yellow Opaque (120ml)
- Indian Yellow (60ml)
- Quinacridone Magenta or Quinacridone Red (60ml)
- Phthalo Green (Blue Shade) (60ml)
- Burnt Sienna, Quinacridone Burnt Orange, Golden Orange or Transparent Brown (60ml)
- Dioxazine Violet/Purple (60ml)
- Unbleached Titanium/Titan Buff (60ml)
- Titanium White (120ml)
- Carbon Black (60ml)
- \*any iridescent metallics or Interference colours you like and/or already have

### **Acrylic Mediums**

- Polymer Medium (Gloss)
- Gel Medium (Gloss)
- Self Leveling Gel (Gloss, 250ml)
- Recycled Texture Medium (Tri-Art, 250ml)
- Modeling Paste (500ml)

### **Brushes - Synthetic Hair/Bristles please!**

A variety of painting brushes for acrylics. Make sure you have a selection of small, medium, and large palette knives and any other utensils\* with which to push paint around, make marks etc.

(\*fondly known as 'domestic goddess tools'!)

### **Supports**

- 1 full sheet of 140lb-200lb watercolour paper
- Min. two 11x14" approx. and two SIZE of your choice! Choose a variety of: masonite (primed), canvas board, stretched canvas, illustration board or birch panel (cradled or uncradled) ... explore surfaces you love or have never tried before!

### **Other**

- Sketch book, pencil/pen
- Gold leaf - loose sheets, leafs or flakes, whatever metallic you like the most & is cheapest
- Apron or wear paint clothes
- Old rags or paper towels
- One small and one medium size metal palette knife with angled handle

- Acrylic paint palette (non-stick preferred)
- Water container
- Spray bottle
- Any reference photos that inspire you
