MATERIALS LIST

Acrylic Paint

Professional quality acrylics. This is my recommended list. Note: It's not necessary to have everything on this list - you are welcome to bring what you have.

- Pyrrole Red Medium or Naphthol Red Light (60ml)
- Phthalo Blue (Green Shade) (60ml)
- Any medium yellow ie. Primary Yellow, Hansa Yellow Opaque (120ml)
- Indian Yellow (60ml)
- Quinacridone Magenta or Quinacridone Red (60ml)
- Burnt Sienna, Quinacridone Burnt Orange, Golden Orange or Transparent Brown (60ml)
- Dioxazine Violet/Purple (60ml)
- Unbleached Titanium/Titan Buff (60ml)
- Titanium White (120ml)
- Carbon Black (60ml)
- Payne's Grey
- *any iridescent metallics or Interference colours you like and/or already have

Acrylic Mediums

- Polymer Medium (Gloss)
- Texture Mediums (optional)

Brushes - Synthetic Hair/Bristles please!

- A variety of painting brushes for acrylics. Make sure you have a selection of small, medium, and large.
- Palette knives and any other utensils* with which to push paint around, make marks etc.
(*fondly known as 'domestic goddess tools'!)

Supports

- 1 full sheet of 140lb-200lb watercolour paper
- One support, SIZE of your choice!

Other

- Gold leaf - loose sheets, leafs or flakes (optional)
- Drawing media ie. paint markers, oil pastels, charcoal etc. (optional)
- Sketch book, pencil/pen
- Old rags or paper towels
- One small and one medium size metal palette knife with angled handle
- Acrylic paint palette (non-stick preferred)
- Water container
- Spray bottle
- Table Cover
- Any landscape reference photos that inspire you

- Apron or wear paint clothes
