## WELCOME TO RIVERWOOD!

**Thank you for visiting! While you are here, please follow our guidelines and help keep Riverwood beautiful and safe for everyone to enjoy!**

### **STAY ON TRAILS & PATHWAYS**

This will help you avoid things like poison ivy, ticks and giant hogweed and keep our wildlife safe and happy.

### **TAKE ONLY PHOTOGRAPHS**

Please **do not** take anything but photographs and leave as little as possible behind. Please place litter in trash cans or take it home with you.

### **RESPECT PLANTS AND WILDLIFE**

Observe animals quietly and do not follow or approach them. Do not pick flowers or plants. Do not step in flowerbeds.

### **RESPECT TEACHING SPACES**

The Enabling Garden is a program space and should be respected. If you see a group of students anywhere, please give them their space.

### **Other guidelines to keep in mind:**

- Students must be supervised at all times while at Riverwood or the Visual Arts Mississauga building.
- Please be mindful of others. Keep noise levels low, especially when in the VAM building.
- Please ensure an adult accompanies students to the washrooms.
- Please do not photograph, lean on or touch artwork on display.
- The possibility of tick-borne Lyme disease exists - avoid going through areas of tall vegetation
- Trails are colour-coded - should you find yourself in distress or come across someone in need of help, please call 911 and tell them which trail you are on.
- Dogs are not allowed off leash
- Bikers must stay on trails and as a courtesy should dismount and walk bikes on boardwalks
